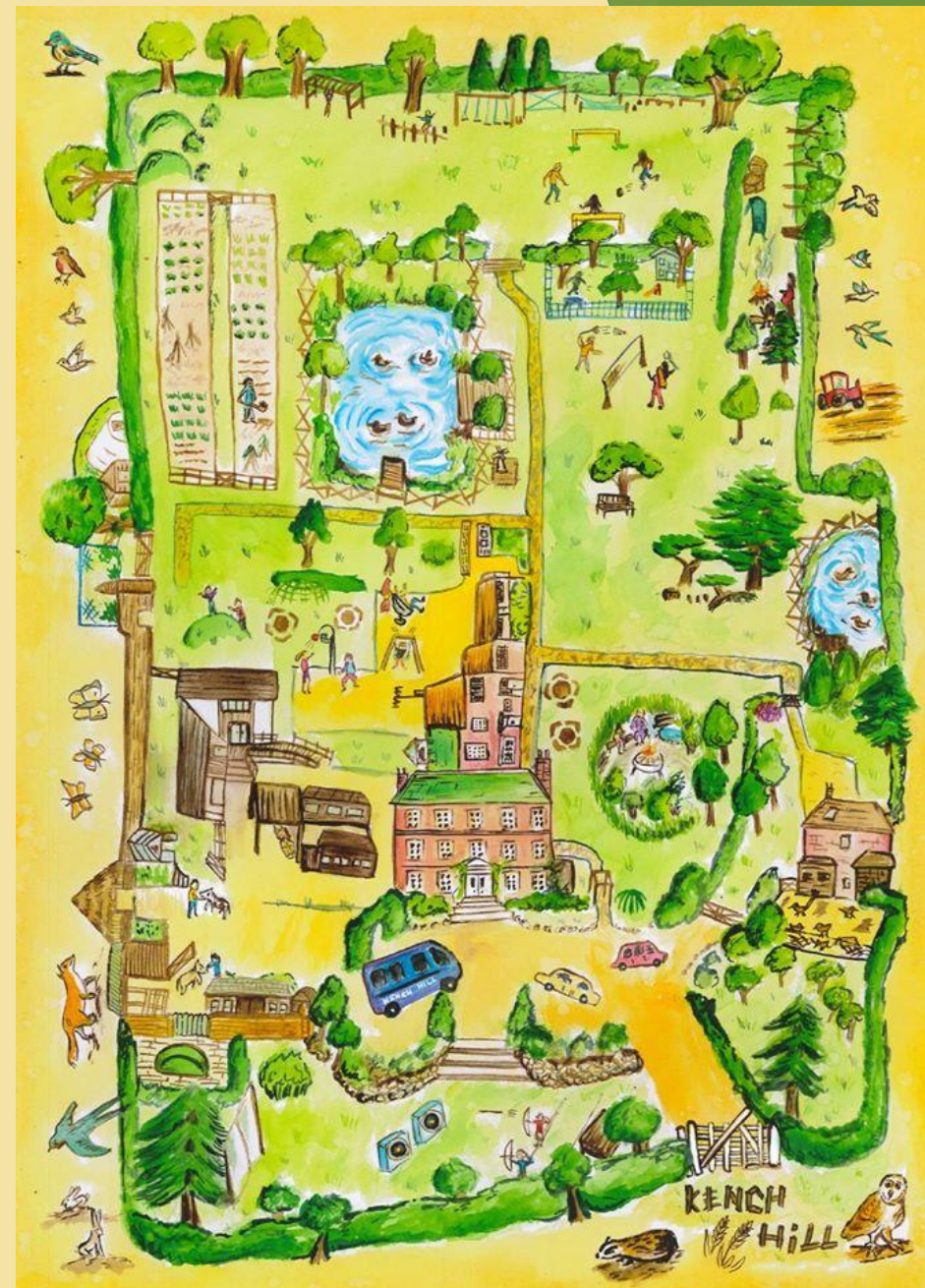

Accommodation

Centre Accommodation and equipment Information

- Max Capacity **53** – (See plans below)
- Bedroom accommodation is on two floors (1st and 2nd) with 4 single/double bedrooms and 7 bedrooms accommodating between 2-10 people, mainly in bunk beds.
- Separate staff room/small lounge with TV, fridge etc. (Doubles up as an accessible bedroom and shower for up to 2 wheelchair users /or 1 double bed)
- Shower and toilet facilities on each floor, with single sex occupancy preferred. Total WC's 14; showers 9.
- 2 large lounges with seating for up to 20 with TV, DVD player, piano, Music Speaker
- Dining room in the main house with seating for up to 40 with cutlery, crockery and glassware. Plastic glasses available.
- Fully equipped catering kitchen with electric and gas ovens, 6 gas burners. Large fridge, small freezer (additional freezer space can be supplied with prior notice).
- Drying racks, iron, ironing board, hair dryers. 1 cot bed, 1 high chair.
- Purpose-built hall with banquet seating for 60+, Wi-Fi, staging (upon request), disco lights.

Sleeping

- ▶ Boys' rooms separate from girls' rooms
- ▶ Bedrooms accommodate between 4 and 12 children each

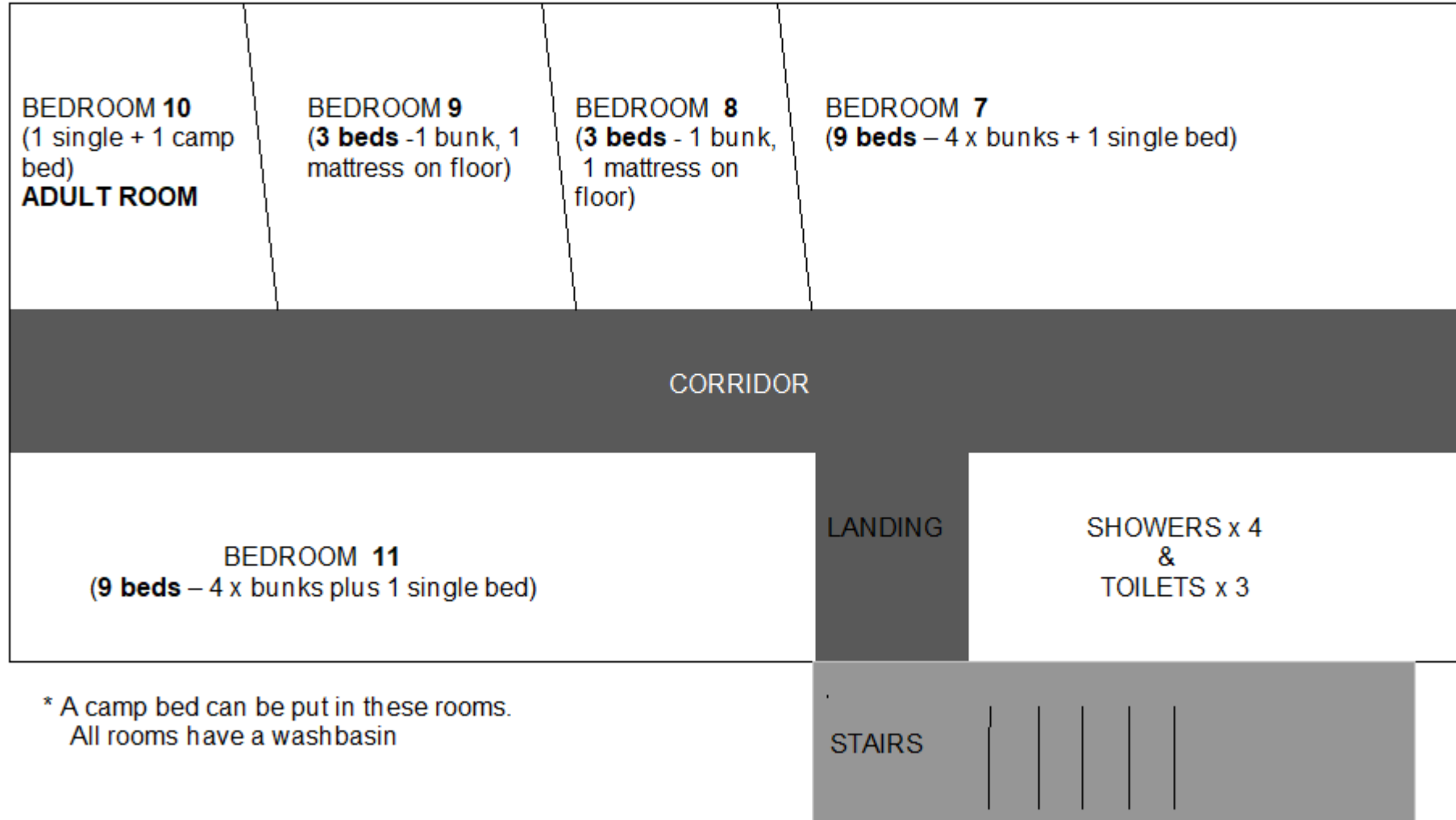

Kench Hill is an outdoor education centre, clothes and shoes will get muddy and wet during our activities.

Please provide appropriate clothing for your children.

Check list

- Towel

 - shampoo
 - hairbrush/comb
 - Toothpaste; toothbrush
 - Any other necessary toiletries
 - Nightclothes
 - Change of underwear and socks (1 per day)
 - Trousers for outdoor activities – nothing new or smart!
 - Shirts or T-shirts
 - Warm jumper
 - Waterproof Coat
 - Shoes for outdoor wear/long walks – there are Wellingtons at Kench Hill which you may borrow.
 - Woolly hat, scarf, gloves and fleece/thick jumper are essential in winter
 - Long, warm socks to wear in Wellington boots.
 - Soft footwear for indoors (trainers or slippers)
 - Sun hat, sunglasses and sun cream in summer months

- It is helpful if all items of clothing are marked with the child's name. We will try to return any left items to the school.

- **No electrical items including MP3's, tablets and phones.**
 - **No food please, all will be provided.**

What NOT to bring

- ▶ Any electronic device including mobile phones, kindles, ipad or electronic cameras
- ▶ Sweets or snacks
- ▶ Any valuable item

Cost

A full payment of £330 includes:

- ▶ Travel (castle and beach travel when there)
