

My child is absent because...

They have symptoms **NOT** relating to COVID 19 or are waiting for COVID 19 test results

1-4 days

The home learning offer is...

Home learning **will not be provided** beyond weekly homework UNLESS the period is longer than 4 days and the child is well enough to complete it.

PLEASE NOTE: If a child is absent due to waiting for a test for over 4 days, you may request work

They are self-isolating due to:

- a positive COVID test for themselves or a member of their household
- having to quarantine
- being contacted by NHS track and trace

10-14 days

Connected: Children need to feel they are still part of the Grasmere community. They will therefore have the opportunity to be in contact with their class teachers through Seesaw and also have zoom chats with their class and teacher and join in Zoom assemblies.

Coherent: The learning will be in context to the work the children are doing this term. It will either practice core skills in literacy/ numeracy but also be linked to the topics being studied. This should help increase accessibility and motivation.

Consistent: Work will be set daily covering all curriculum areas during absence.

Their bubble is closed and the whole class needs to self-isolate

14 days +

Connected: Children will have daily live video link up with their class and teacher to outline the work on Seesaw. They will also be able to tune in when the rest of the school is having assemblies on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Coherent: The lesson content would be very similar to if they were in school. For example, if the teacher was planning on doing multiplication in maths, this would still be the case. The flow and rhythm of learning would not be lost.

Consistent: The daily offer will more closely mirror a school day.

General points to note:

- This is only relevant IF your child is well enough to complete work
- If your child has additional needs, work will often be set by your child's LSA and might be tailored to ensure access.
