Year 1 have had a fantastic start to their maths learning. We have been learning how to use a ten frame to represent objects and numbers.

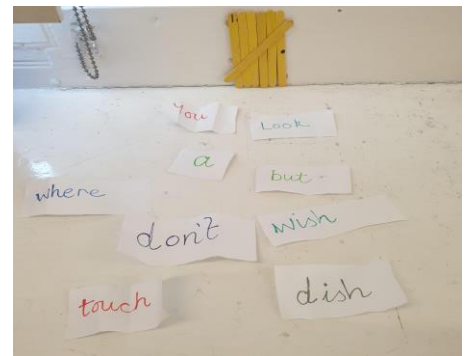


Year 2 have started their new Science Topic Animals and their habitats. We went to the garden and found lots of mini beasts and looked at their
