All smiles in Year 1 this week as they jumped into a new half term. Here we are having lots of fun during our Daily Mile!



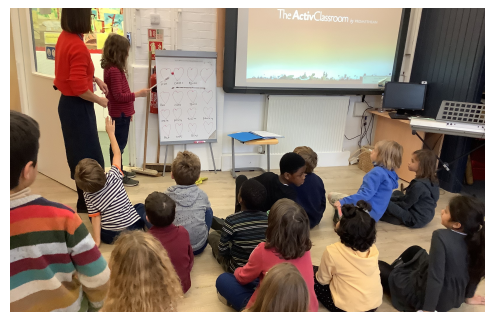
### **Year Two- Simone Biles Class**

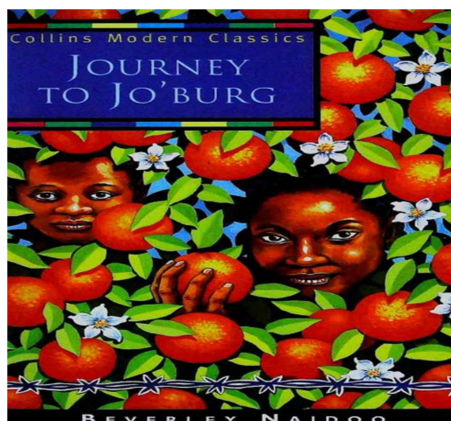
### **Year Four- Malala Class**
