This is an exciting topic which will include planting, measuring and creative activities.*



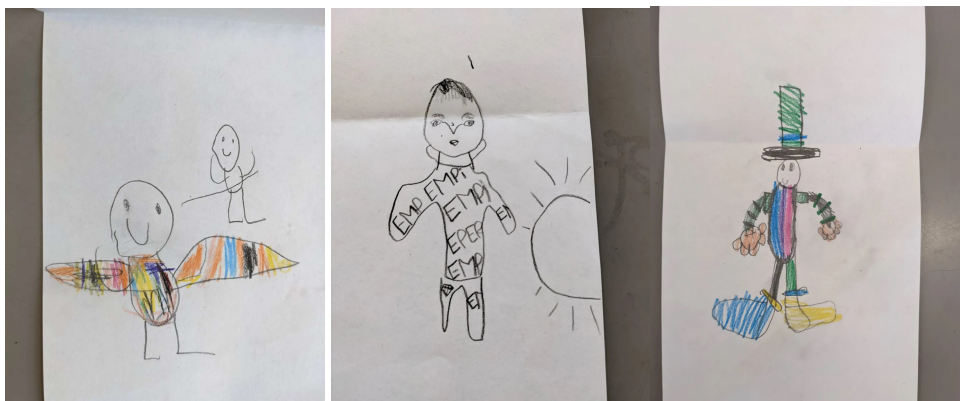
## YEAR ONE – ROSEN CLASS
