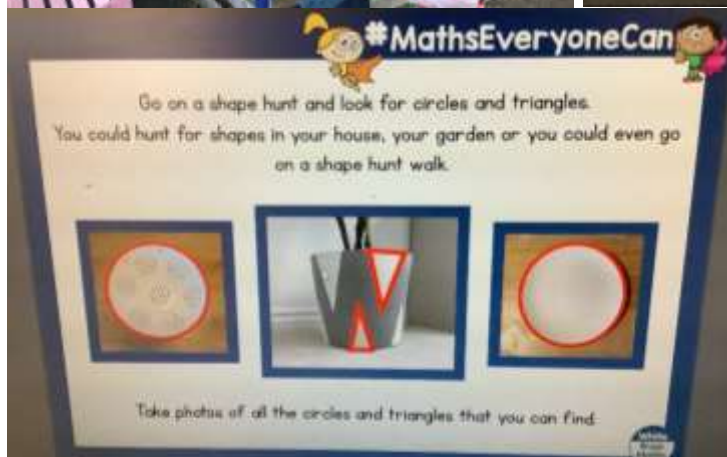
Nursery – Lin-Manuel Miranda class
