Nursery – Lin-Manuel Miranda class

The nursery children went on a trip this week to the Garden Classroom where we learnt about plants and how they grow. We were able to dig up weeds and try different vegetables grown in the garden.







Reception – Elvis class

In Reception this week in science we have been looking at plants and what they need to grow. We planted beans in bags and also cress. We are so excited to watch them grow.

In Maths we have been working on making pairs, and how many we need in a group to make equal numbers of pairs.



Year one – Dolly Parton class

This week Dolly Class have been thinking hard about number sentences. We used the scales to show us that the numbers either side of the equal sign must be the same. It was very interesting to see the scale tilt when the numbers weren't equal. It has really helped us when working on fact families!

Nina Class put on both their history and science hats today to develop their understanding of the human skeleton. We loved building our own skeletons!










Year four - Jimmy Cliff class


