

In Lin-Manuel Miranda Class this week we have been making up our own stories and drawing story maps. We started with Once upon a time Then we had to think of who we wanted the story to be about, where the story was set, and what happened!







Reception – Elvis class

In Reception class we have been working on teen numbers this week in Maths. We have been learning that you need to make a group of 10 and add some more to make a teen number. We used tens frames to make the number and could understand that a filled tens frame represented 10 and we did not need to then count the individual cubes. We will be doing lots of work of recognising and counting teen numbers over the next few weeks.

Year Four – Jimmy Cliff class


We had a fantastic time at the Garden Classroom with Siri, we explored and played in the beautiful garden and learnt a lot about habitats and adaptations. What a treat!
