Nina Class were exceptional at showing all of the Grasmere values this week at Sports Day. Their cheers were heard across the field! Great sportsmanship, Nina Class!



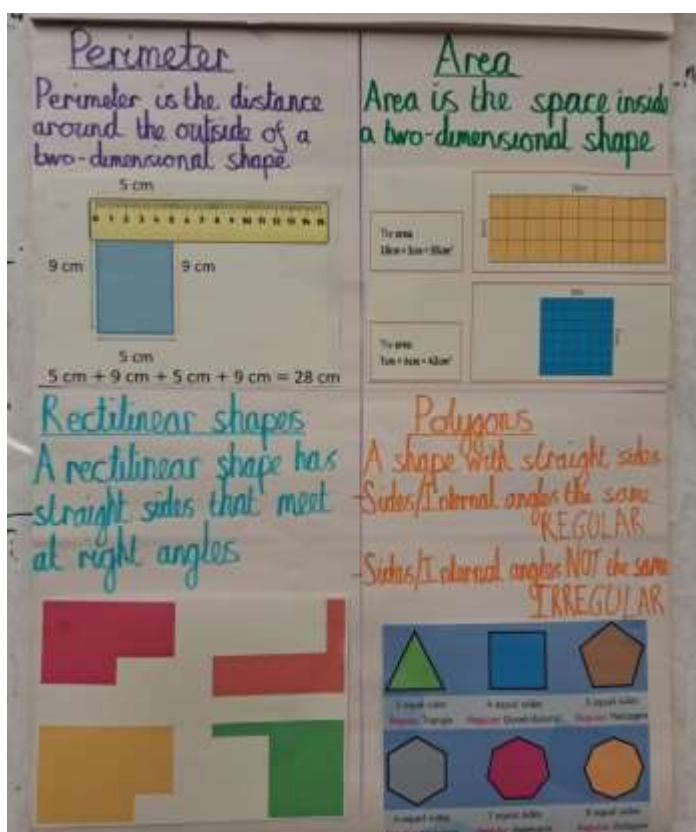
Year Four – Jimmy Cliff class

We had a brilliant time this week, focusing on lots of opportunities for whole class and independent reading. We loved sports day too, what a joy!



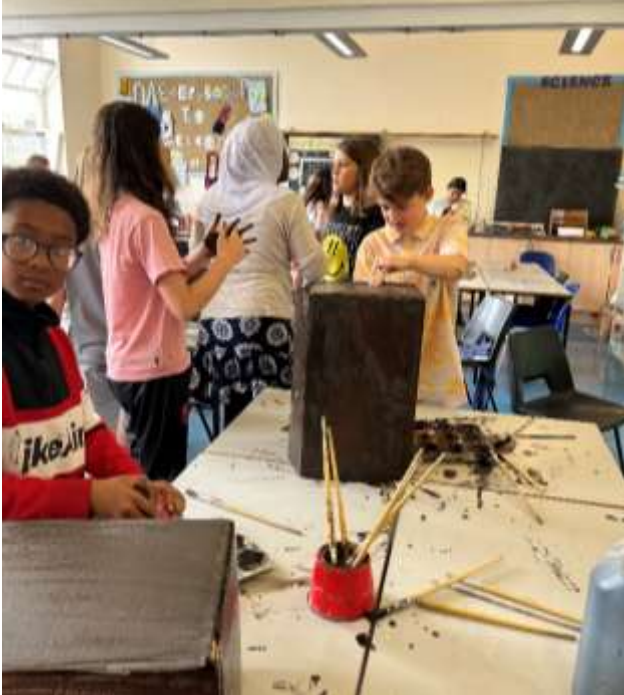
Year Five – Duke Ellington class
