Nursery – London Eye class

This week in London Eye class, we have been learning about our Senses. We tasted some of the 3 bears porridge. We listened to the sound of the instruments. Year One – Kew Gardens Class

This week Kew Gardens Class have been exploring the greater than, less than and equal to symbols in maths. They used cubes and rulers to prove which number was greater or less than another and impressed their teachers with their great mathematical language. Well done all!





Year Two – St Paul's class

This week year 2 have been practicing their throwing and catching skills in PE, to apply to their cricket lessons.







Year Three - Big Ben class

We've had a great time this week in Big Ben Class. We are making paper mache ancient Greek vases with Barley. A bit messy, but lots of fun!



Year Four – Tower Bridge class

We had a brilliant time learning outdoors this week, we collected sticks and twigs to make number lines to 10,000. The children were fantastic, they engaged so well and use mathematical language to explain their thinking.







Year Five – Ally Pally class

This week, Ally Pally Class began to learn about the Solar System in Science. We identified each planet and its position in the solar system, discovered how they are formed and discussed key terms such as orbiting, and why it occurs. We then began to build our own solar systems!







Year Six – Globe Theatre class

Year 6 have all continued to be superstars this week! We have been exploring factors, multiples, prime, square and cube numbers this week in maths, and using counters to deepen our understanding.
