Parent feedback....

From time to time parents will ask us how we use technology is used in school. As educators we are always reminded in training that we are teaching children for jobs that don't even exist yet when it comes to technology. In school we give them the skills, focusing on the strands of digital literacy, computer science and Information Technology. You can find out more here:

In school we use a range of resources, our brand new micro: bits:

and also a range of laptops, IPADs, Beebots and much more. We use the interactive whiteboard throughout the day to bring in a range of quality carefully chosen resources that enhance the children's learning.

Staff also focus very much on online safety and being safe on line, as well as keeping healthy and encouraging children to manage the amount of screen time and non-screen time they have at home.

How do we teach about...

Maths. The teaching of Maths has changed greatly over the last few years. At Grasmere we use White Rose for maths. This curriculum is inclusive in that it has an expectation that all children will learn and learn together. It also provides valuable moments for extra support and scaffolds as well as stretch and challenge.

The use of manipulatives is a positive thing, and involves children knowing how to use blocks, cubes, counters and more to support them in their mathematical understanding., That understanding is revisited frequently, and deepened through the use of problem solving.

News from the classes...

Nursery – London Eye class

London Eye class have been learning about Remembrance. We listen to the story of Poppy Day and painted our own beautiful poppies.





Reception – William Morris class

In William Morris class we have been learning about Remembrance Day. We watched a BBC animation which used beautiful imagery to signify War time and the significance of poppy fields. We then made beautiful pictures with images connected to Remembrance Day. The class really enjoyed doing their assembly and they are already learning some songs for the school Nativity in December.







Year One – Kew Gardens Class

Kew Gardens class has a special visit from Zoolab this week to learn about senses in Science. We used our sense of touch to describe how different animals felt. The children really enjoyed getting up-close and personal with a variety of wonderful creatures and learning some very interesting facts about them!







Year Two - St Paul's class

We talked about the value of remembrance and the reasons November is such a big month for it in St. Paul's class. We have been studying Walter Tull in our history topic. Walter Tull was recommended for the military cross but never received one, so we decided to design medals in his honour since we have been studying such an incredibly heroic soldier.



Year Three - Big Ben class

This week we had one final session with Barley to complete our Ancient Greek Vases. This has been such a fun project, and we feel really proud to now see them on display around the school!



Year Four – Tower Bridge class

Year 4 had a brilliant week of lessons, a favourite being when we turned our classroom into a fancy restaurant and had Patrick the chef talks us through the specials menu.


Year Five – Ally Pally class
